Competition Format-

2 round

(Ist round will be conducted online before the event date.)

(2nd round will be conducted during the event- shortlisted entries)

How the competition will be conducted (stages, submission format)-

Team will submit 03 component:

- A 3-minute video OR 03 Power Point slides showcasing the design features, benefits, and impact of the kiosk.
- A2-sized coloured sheets (maximum 02) detailing the design, features, and functionality of the kiosk.
- One sheet (provided during the event) that can be used to add additional design details or features.

Judging Criteria-

Creativity: Uniqueness and innovation in the design.

Functionality: Practicality and usability of the kiosk in an urban setting. It should fit within the context of an urban environment (e.g., parks, plazas, public transport stations).

Aesthetic Appeal: Visual design and how it enhances the public space.

Key evaluation parameters.

Prizes and recognitions for winners.

Rules & Regulations-

Time Limit:

- Teams will have 2.0 hours during the event to draw their design on the provided sheets.
- A 03-minute video or PPT slides, and A2 printed colored sheets (maximum 02) can be prepared in advance.
- The design and detailing to be presented on one given sheet.
- All three components (video/PPT, A2 colored sheets, and handmade sheet) will be counted as the final submission.
