2. Categories and Eligibility

- Open to all participants (Internal as well as External students).
- A team should have at least 5 members and at max 12 members
- The time limit of each skit must not exceed 15 minutes.

3. Registration and Fees

- **Participation Fee:** Rs 100 per student

4. Leafy Paradise Format

- Participants must register on the website

- All the participants must follow the theme
 - Participants must create visually appealing arrangement using leafy plants.
 - At the time of registration participants must upload the picture of foliage arrangement.
 - Final selection of the participants will be selected on the basis of the photos uploaded by them.

5. Rules

- Participants must adhere to the specified theme of the competition.
 - The time limit of each skit must not exceed 30 minutes.
 - Exceeding the time limit may result in deduction in marks.
 - Participants can use any 5 types of plants. Participants must possess knowledge about the plants they are using.
 - Participants are not allowed to use any artificial leaves, flowers and artificial flowers.
 - The core committee reserves the right to disqualify entries that breach university policies or rules.
 - Participants can use props required as per their ideas.
 - Participant will be responsible to arrange and bring all the material for foliage arrangement.
 - It is not a team-based competition.
