4. Eligibility Criteria:

Only faculty and staff from university, college and school.

5. Registration Process (How to register and any fees involved.)

- a) Solo participation- Rs. 150
- b) Group participation- Rs. 150 per participant of the group

Competition Format –

- There will be two rounds-
 - Screening round and Final round (Depending on the number of entries)

6. Judging Criteria: Key evaluation parameters

A panel of Judges will evaluate performance based on the criteria defined. Based on the cumulative score, results will be declared accordingly. The criteria for judgment are:

Clarity, Quality of Execution, Audience engagement, Expression

All concerns and disputes must be addressed to the designated officials of the event. The decision taken by the designated officials will be final.

7. Prizes & Awards (Prizes and recognitions for winners)

- ✓ The top three performers in solo and group each category will be awarded prizes and certificates.
- ✓ There will be two prizes in each category as Judges Special Prize

10. Rules & Regulations (Participation guidelines and restrictions)

- i. Instruments or karaoke are not allowed to support singing.
- ii. Time limit for each category is 3 Minutes (Maximum)
- iii. First buzzer will ring to start the event
- iv. Warning buzzer will ring after 2.5 min
- v. Final buzzer will ring once 3 minutes are over.

- vii. Prior information to be given to the organizing committee regarding their arrangements
