1. Introduction

The Virtual Vortex Online Gaming Event is a thrilling competition for gaming enthusiasts across Uttar Pradesh. Featuring popular titles like **Valorant** and **BGMI**, this event provides a platform for players to showcase their tactical skills, teamwork, and gaming prowess. Open to both seasoned gamers and newcomers, Virtual Vortex promises an electrifying experience.

2. Categories and Eligibility

- Valorant (PC):
 - Open to all participants (Internal as well as External students).
 - Teams must consist of 5 main players and 1 substitute.
 - Each player must have a Riot Games account.
- BGMI (Mobile):
 - Open to all participants (Internal as well as External students).
 - Teams must consist of 4 main players and 1 substitute.
 - Each player must have a BGMI account linked to their IGN.
- TEKKEN 7(Offline)
 - Open to all participants (Internal as well as External students).

 Participants can register for both categories but must ensure no schedule clashes.

3. Registration and Fees

• Participation Fee: Rs 150

4. Tournament Format

Valorant:

- Knockout rounds followed by semi-finals and finals.
- Maps will be pre-selected for each round.
- Scoring will follow the official Riot Games Competitive Ruleset.

BGMI:

- Matches will be conducted in TPP Squad Mode.
- Maps include Erangel, Miramar, and Sanhok (rotational).
- Scoring is based on placement points and kills.

TEKKEN 7:

- Qualifiers (Double Elimination):
- Players compete in a double-elimination bracket.
- Lose twice, and you're out of the tournament.
- Matches are best of 3 games (first to 2 wins).
- This continues until 3 players remain.
- Finals (Round Robin):
- The top 3 players from the qualifiers compete in a round-robin format.
- Each player faces the other two players in a best-of-5 match (first to 3 wins).
- Players are eliminated after 3 losses in the finals.
- The player with the most wins is declared the champion.
- Tournament brackets and match schedules will be shared before the event.

5. Rules and Gameplay

General Rules:

- Use of hacks, cheats, or any third-party software is strictly prohibited and will result in disqualification.
- Players must maintain a stable internet connection and ensure their devices meet game requirements.
- Toxic behavior, offensive language, or unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated.

Valorant:

- o Players must join the provided custom lobby on time.
- Use of any unapproved agents or glitches will result in penalties.

BGMI:

- Participants must use their registered accounts only.
- Any unauthorized third-party peripherals or mods are prohibited.

Tekken 7:

Participants can bring their own contollers or keyboards.

6. Judging and Dispute Resolution

- A panel of gaming experts will oversee the event and address any disputes.
- Match referees' decisions will be final.

7. Safety and Regulations

- Ensure compliance with fair gameplay standards.
- Players must adhere to the event's code of conduct to foster a positive and safe gaming environment.

8. Awards and Recognition

Total prize pool of 30,000/- 10k each to winning teams of BGMI and Valorant. 5k each to runner ups
