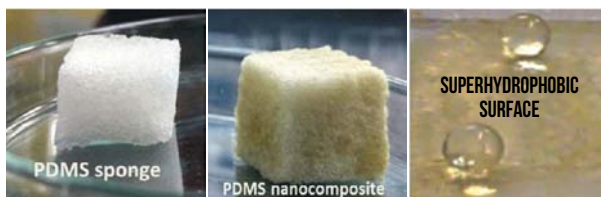

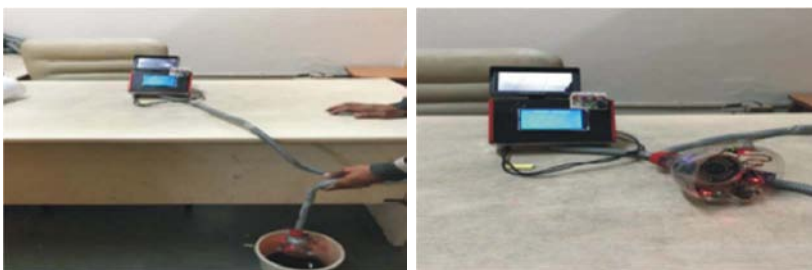

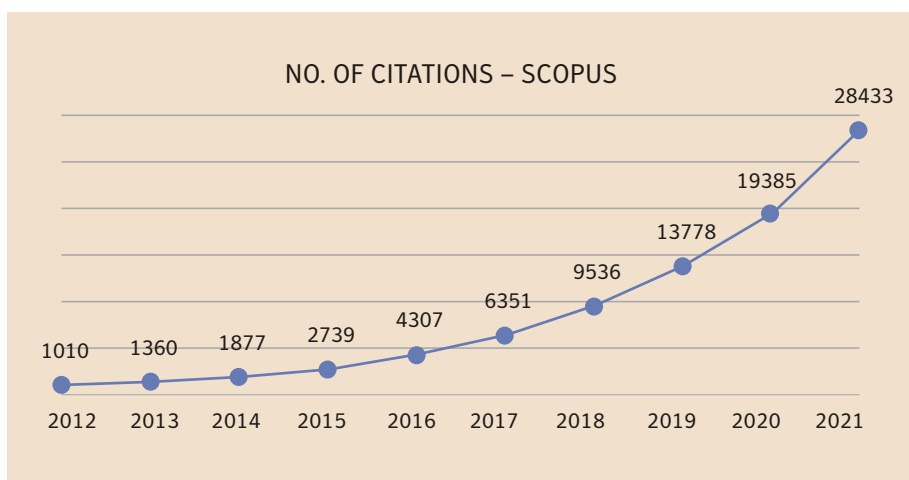

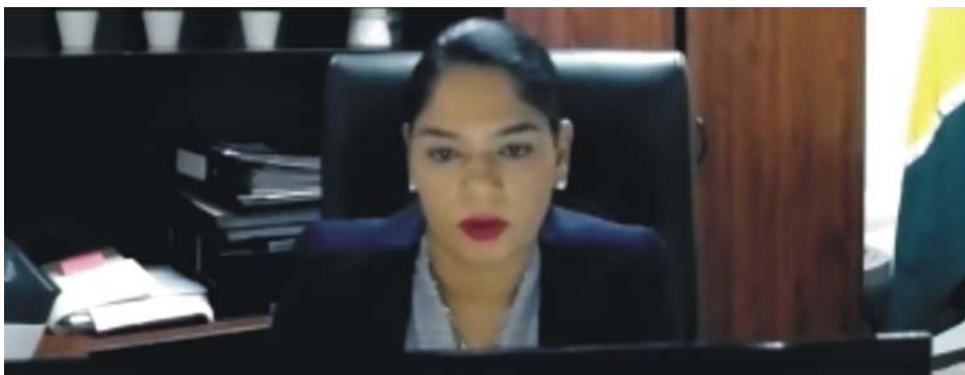

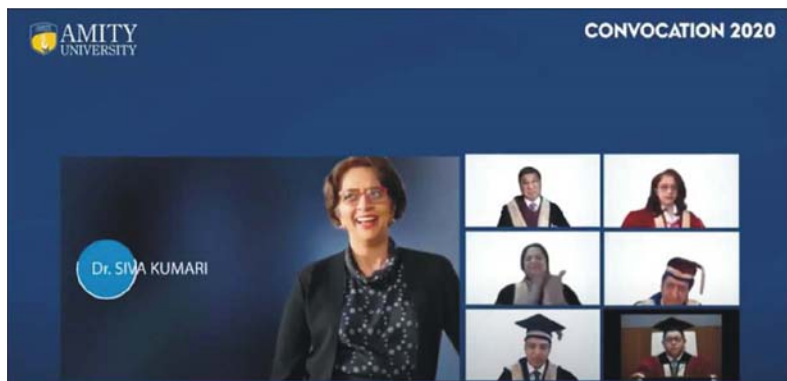

Driven by a vision to develop innovative remedies for developing world healthcare challenges, Dr. Ella, a first generation entrepreneur, established Bharat Biotech International Limited in 1996, with a business plan to create cheaper hepatitis vaccine.

Bharat Biotech has delivered billions of vaccine doses to the poorest in over 150 developing countries. With over 115 patents, the company today has over 12 vaccines in its portfolio.

Always an outstanding scholar, completed his Masters in Plant Pathology from University of Hawaii on a Rotary Fellowship and then earned his Ph.D in Biochemistry from University of Wisconsin-Madison, USA.

Under Dr. Ella's transformational leadership, Bharat Biotech has now become the first company to manufacture a preservative-free vaccine (Revac-B mcf Hepatitis B Vaccine), launched India's first cell-cultured swine-flu vaccine, manufactured the world's cheapest Hepatitis vaccine and was the first in the world to find a vaccine for the Zika virus. The company has supplied 3 billion doses of vaccines globally. Through his innovative approaches, the company supplied 35 million doses for the National Immunisation Programme at a very affordable price.

When the scientific community of the whole world was struggling to find remedy for Covid pandemic, Bharat Biotech, under his inspiring leadership, created history by producing India's First COVID-19 Vaccine, 'COVAXIN', a significant contribution towards Atmanirbhar Bharat.

Dr. Ella is also involved in shaping India's science education and policy through his association with several committees such as Scientific Advisory Committee to the Union Cabinet, CSIR Governing Council, CCMB Governing Council and Research Council for CSIR National Laboratories.
