Eco-Champ Activities

On the occasion of world environment day on june 5th 2024 we have participated in the Eco-Champ Activity program and conducted various activities at different places. The description is as follows:

Activity Title: Make Your Own Envelopes Workshop

Date of Activity: 04/06/2024, 07/06/2024, 12/07/2024, 13/06/2014, 17/06/2024

Description: AIE conducted the activity at four various NGOs for two days. Participants learned how to make envelopes using old paper, promoting reuse and recycling to reduce waste. The workshop aimed to empower individuals to adopt sustainable practices in their daily lives. We divided the students into two groups, one group was under my supervision and the other was under her supervision. First, we took the sheets and asked them to watch us then do the same. The students were very enthusiastic while doing this activity and they found it very interesting because it was something new to them and they enjoyed it so much. The fresh energy was seen on their happy faces. Even I also enjoyed this session and they all made so colourful and creative Envelopes.

Activity Title: Plastic Ban: Advocate for the prohibition or restriction of single-use plastics to reduce pollution and protect the environment.

Date of Activity: 05/06/2024

Description: On June 5th, AIE conducted an engaging and informative activity in our NGO, that focused on the ban of single-use plastics. The event was designed to raise awareness among students about the harmful effects of plastic pollution on the environment. Through a series of educational sessions, students learned about the harmful impacts of plastic waste on wildlife, marine life, and human health. They were introduced to the concept of sustainable alternatives to single-use plastics, such as reusable bags, bottles, and containers. The interactive discussions

helped students understand the importance of reducing plastic consumption and motivated them to adopt eco-friendly practices in their daily lives.

Activity Title: Encouraging sustainable habits

Date of Activity: 10/06/2024

Description: A workshop and awareness campaign was organized for the participants to make them understand the usage of sustainable daily items like steel water bottles/boxes/bags is beneficiary instead of plastic water bottles/boxes/bags as they harm the environment and are not eco-friendly. We explained the benefits of the sustainable environmental habits and harms of plastic items to them. The outcome of the activity is awareness towards sustainability. Participants reported a heightened awareness of the environmental issues caused by plastic bags and expressed a willingness to change their habits. Post-workshop interaction indicated high levels of satisfaction among participants, who appreciated the practical approach and the opportunity to make a tangible difference.

Activity Title: DIY Cloth Bag Workshop

Date of Activity: 12/06/2024, 14/06/2024,17/06/2024

Description:

AIE organised a workshop on making your own cloth bags to promote the use of cloth bags as a sustainable alternative and to provide practical demonstrations on making and using cloth bags. Participants learned how to make cloth bags by hand using old clothes or blankets. This hands-on workshop promoted sustainability by reducing the use of plastic bags and repurposing old material. This also encouraged participation in sustainable habits by using recycled cloth bags instead of polythene bags Students can save money by using handmade bags. Can start small businesses selling handmade bags. And it will also Improve student's art and craft skills. Many participants learned how to create their own cloth bags, which they can continue to use and teach others. The workshop fostered a sense of community, with participants engaging in discussions and planning further initiatives to reduce plastic waste.

Activity Title: Grow Your Own Organic Vegetable Garden

Date of Activity: 11/06/2024

Description: On June 11th AIE has organised an activity to promote sustainability and protecting the environment. Participants learned how to sow seeds and plant the crops with proper irrigation for the growth of different crops like onion, mustard, sugarcane, etc.

They learned the whole process of growing a crop and taking care of crops in an organic manner by providing crops with useful Manure like cow dung. This activity help them to be aware of the agricultural practices of India and they get to know the work done by Indian farmers as well as the problems faced by them to grow the crops in a proper manner. The "Grow Your Own Organic Vegetable Garden" workshop successfully achieved its goals of educating participants on organic gardening and promoting sustainable living practices. The positive outcomes and feedback highlight the potential for ongoing and expanded efforts in this area.

Activity Title: Green Living Date of Activity: 13/06/2024

Description: On June 13th, AIE conducted an engaging and informative workshop with three

activities

- 1. Environmental Posters: Participants created posters to raise awareness about various environmental issues and the importance of sustainable living.
- 2. Planting: Participants learned how to plant and care for small plants in pots, promoting urban gardening and the benefits of having greenery in limited spaces.
- 3. Cleanliness Drive: Participants engaged in a community cleanliness drive, picking up litter and promoting the importance of maintaining clean public spaces.

Activity Title: E-Waste Collection Point

We also told them about how even the Garbage trucks have a separate compartment for E-waste collection and disposal. The children at Jagshanti Udayan Ghar were very passionate about the activity and asked multiple questions regarding the topic. The session was very productive and engaging.

Activity Title: Waste Segregation
Date of Activity: 14 /06/2024

Description: AIE conducted a workshop on Waste Segregation on June 14th 2024. The workshop was organized to educate participants on the importance of proper waste management and segregation practices. The aim was to provide practical knowledge on how to effectively separate waste at the source, reducing landfill waste, promoting recycling, and contributing to a cleaner environment. The Key Activities of the workshop were:1. Introduction to Waste Management which includes types of waste and explanations of different types of waste, such as; organic, recyclable, hazardous, and e-waste. Segregation,2. Techniques: Practical demonstrations on how to segregate waste at home, school, or workplace, using color-coded bins and other methods. 3. Composting: Recycling and Upcycling: 4. Interactive Q&A Session: An opportunity for participants to ask questions and share their experiences with waste management. The positive response and active engagement of participants highlight the potential for significant environmental impact through continued education and community involvement.

Activity Title: Sewing Machine Installation:

Recognising the importance of having the right tools, we approached our uncle, Anuj Goel who owns a manufacturing unit in Noida who generously donated one of his extra sewing machines. This gesture was crucial in making the workshop accessible to all participants. Students were engaged in learning process and took vow that they will never use plastic bags or anything related tom plastic in their life. Not only this they will also make sure that they will stop others too and make them aware about its use and how much harmful it is for the environment.
