He is member of several Committees of NRDC, constituted to run various Programmes of the Corporation.

He has more than eight years of valuable experience in the field of Technology Transfer, Sourcing & assessing of various Technologies and dealt numerous technologies emanated from premier research institutes of the country, like ICMR, CSIR, AIIMS, ICAR, Universities etc, in

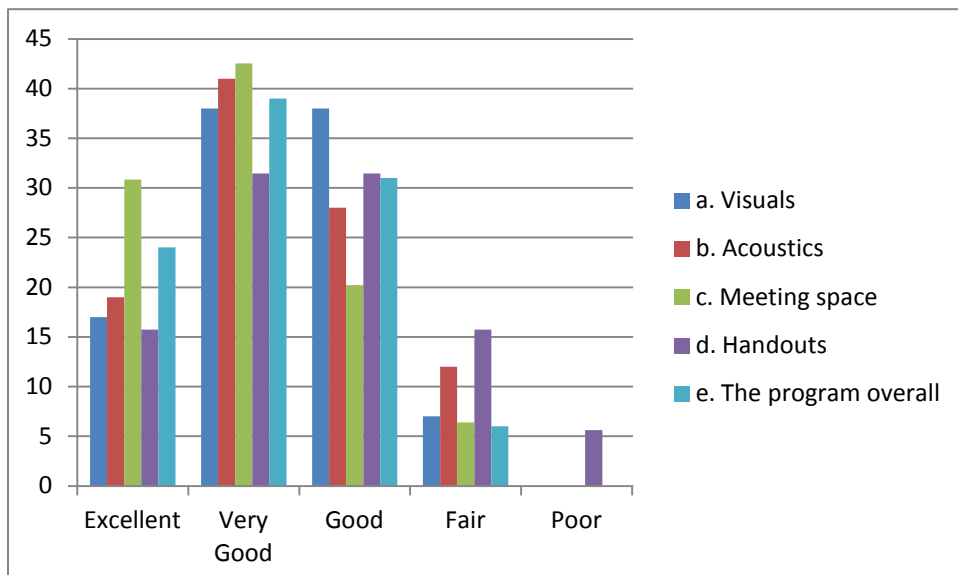
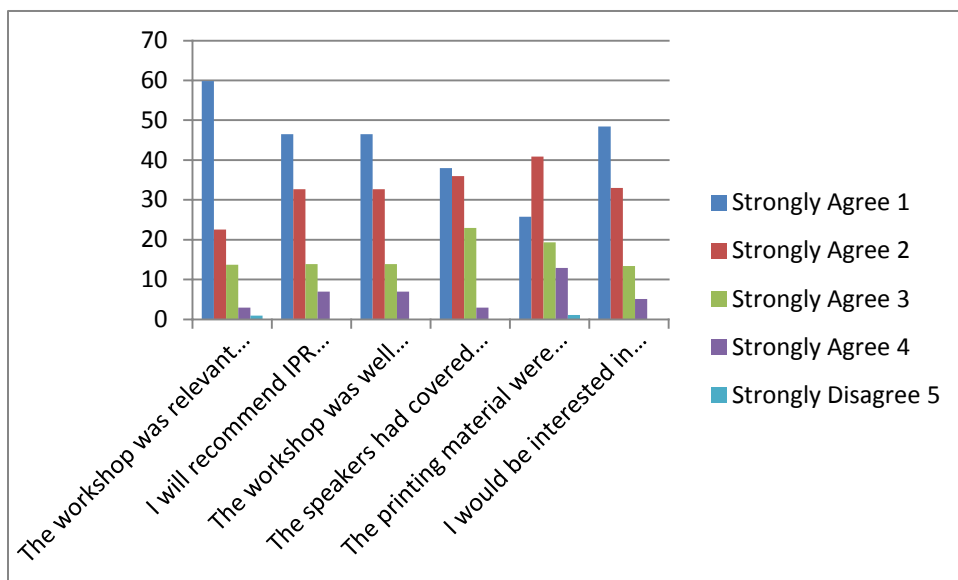
