

## PROCEEDINGS OF WORKSHOP

1. A workshop on “**Innovation and Intellectual Property Rights (IPR)**”, was organized on March 3, 2015 in Multipurpose Hall, Auditorium Block, Amity University Uttar Pradesh, Lucknow campus, India

### 2. **About the workshop**

This Workshop is an initiative under the National Research Development Corporation (NRDC) and Amity Innovation facilitation centre (IFC) scheme. The IFC scheme of NRDC has specific objectives, though the scheme has larger scope and it is still evolving. It is expected that during the operation of scheme, new ideas will be generated in consultation with all stakeholders in the country which shall be shared with NRDC from time to time.

NRDC-AMITY IFC is acting as Nodal agency and plays the role of prime mover, being the first one to take IFC initiatives in right direction, to make the IFC scheme of NRDC a great success. The NRDC-AMITY IFC is organizing events in other institutions in the NCR, so that other institutes in the region can be benefitted from the experience of NRDC-AMITY IFC. Around 60 participants (including faculties and PG level students) participated in this workshop.

The guest speakers for this workshop are senior scientists of national research laboratories. It is expected that this workshop will help in spreading the awareness among the students and researchers.

### 6(i) Speaker's Brief Profile

- (1) **Dr. Ramesh Kumar Srivastava** (Sr. Principal Scientist, Fragrance and Flavour Development Research institute, Kannauj, UP)

Dr. Srivastava did his M.Sc from RML university, Faizabad in 1995 and Ph.D from CIMAP, Lucknow. He is working in Fragrance and Flavour Development Research institute, Kannauj, UP as Head from June, 2002. He has published 55 papers in national and international journals. He presented 21 papers in national and international seminars. He guided more than 35 students of M.Sc. and M.Tech for their project work and 3 Ph.D. students. He independent handled 12 R&D and extension projects from various funding agencies like NMPB, DST, DBT, Govt. Of Gujarat, UPCST, MEA, MSME, etc.

- (2) **Dr. Vinay Tripathi**, Senior Principal Scientist & Head, Division of S&T Management, CSIR-Central Drug Research Institute, Lucknow

Dr. Vinay Tripathi is keenly involved in the area of intellectual property management and has 25 years experience in the area. He has completed two Internships viz. on Intellectual Property Rights and Technology Transfer at Michigan State University, USA and National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases and the Office of the

Technology Transfer, NIH, Bethesda, USA. Presently, he is taking care of IPR Management of CDRI along with Project Monitoring & evaluation, HRD, Internal publications, etc. So far he has processed filling of 332 Indian Patent applications, 393 foreign patent applications out of them 247 Indian Patents and 206 foreign patents have been granted.

**(3) Dr. Sanjay Kumar**, Sr. Scientist, Central Institute of Medicinal and Aromatic Plants, Lucknow

Dr. Sanjay has published 20 research papers and given 10 TV and radio talk on different topics. He handles 8 projects as PI and in 3 projects he was Co-PI. He has received FICCI and CSIR awards for rural development in 2005 and 2008 respectively. He is involved in medicinal and aromatic plants based technology transfer of herbal products, processes, plant varieties, technique, rendering consultancies from industries, organization of the entrepreneurship development programmes, organization of business meets and farmers fair, farmers industry meets, developed a PPP model for contractual cultivation of medicinal and aromatic plants. Specially *Artemisia annua* an anti malarial drug plant.

**(4) Dr. Rajinder Kumar Diwan**, Addl. Director, DITT, Amity University Uttar Pradesh, Noida.

Dr. Diwan was associated with Sriram Institute of Industrial research. In Amity University he has developed many innovative and patentable products and providing help to others in developing innovative and patentable product.

Dr. Dwivedi worked as Sr. consultant and R&D head at Samtel, Gr. Noida. He was also associated with CSIR-CEERI, Pilani, Rajasthan as Sr. Scientist.
