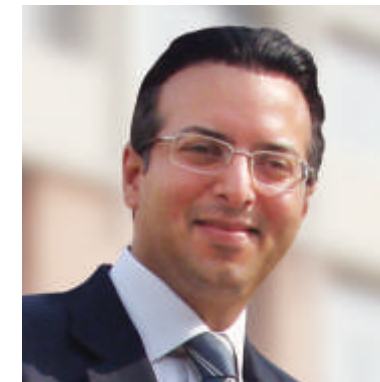
MESSAGE FROM CHAIRPERSON

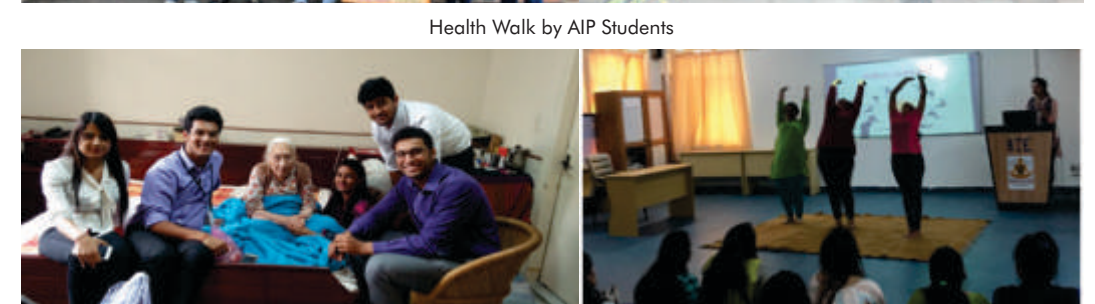

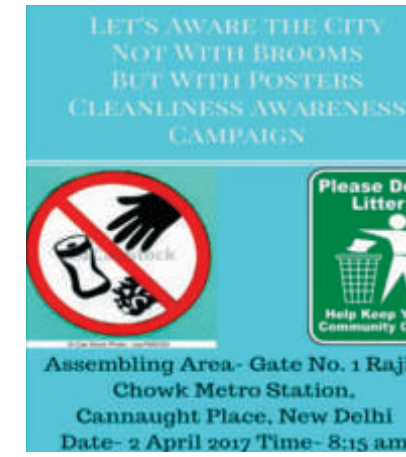
