UG ORIENTATION SESSION REPORT

The UG Orientation Session for the students of the 1st year was conducted in online and offline modes from 25th August 2025 to 27th August 2025. The offline session was held on 27th August 2025 in K1-402.

Prof. (Dr.) Pradeep Joshi, Group Addl. Pro Vice-Chancellor, Director General & Dean (Applied Arts/Fine Arts/Performing Arts/Visual Arts), welcomed the students and guided them on the essential procedures to be followed during the registration process. He emphasized that students should first approach their respective faculty or Programme Leader (PL) in case of any queries, and if not resolved, they may reach out to the office of the GAPVC.

He highlighted the expectations that family members have from students and encouraged them to work diligently to fulfil these. He stressed the importance of attendance, mentioning that a minimum of 75% attendance is mandatory to appear in exams, however students should focus on attaining 100% attendance. He further informed that the programme structure has been revised, with all courses now carrying 4 credits.

GAPVC also shared that eminent artists have previously visited the Fine Arts Department, giving students valuable opportunities to learn from their experiences. Encouraging proactive engagement, he advised students to visit galleries, participate in inter-college art competitions, and take part in ventures that help sharpen their skills and broaden their exposure.

A **Faculty Interaction Session** was also conducted, where all the faculty members introduced themselves and gave a brief overview of their respective streams and the courses they teach. This helped students become familiar with the faculty and their areas of expertise.

Dr. Khushboo Chaturvedi, Associate Professor & Club Coordinator, emphasized the importance of student clubs and informed the students that certificates will be awarded for participation in various activities. Other institutional club coordinators introduced their respective clubs and shared details about the activities planned for the year.

Following this, the Mentor-Mentee Session was conducted by Mr. Sachin Ahuja, Assistant Professor & Mentor-Mentee Coordinator. He explained the mentor system and guided students on how they could approach their mentors for support regarding academic or personal concerns.
