

Departmental Event Report: Essay Writing Competition

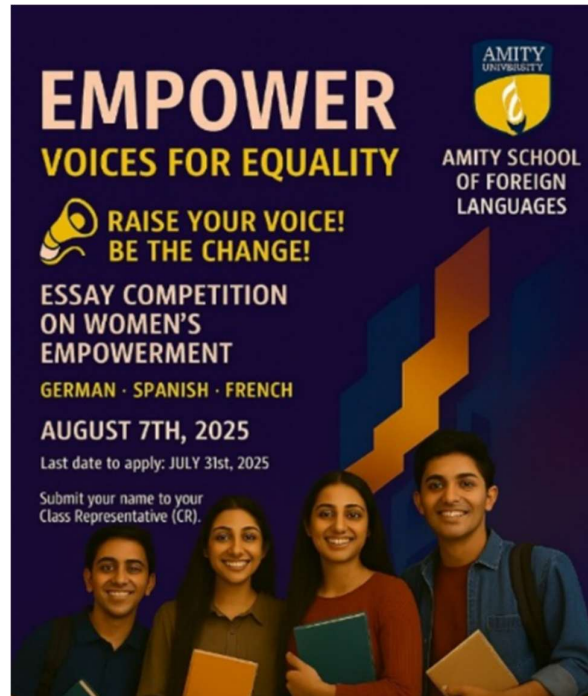
