Majorly the following works / achievements were deliberated and the suggestions, thereto, are noted.</li> <li>Research Activities / Projects: 08 funded projects (7-Govt. / 1-Industry) worth 294.57 lakhs</li> <li>Consultancy: 06 funded consultancy projects worth 241.41 lakhs</li> <li>Under State Rural Livelihood Mission (BIHAN), 250 women folks from CG tribal belts are trained – Funding of INR1.07 Cr.</li> <li>Extension Activities – More than 40 outreach activities</li> <li>AUC IIC is appointed as Mentor Institution for five mentees from pan India, by MoE with a funding of INR 1 Cr.</li> <li>IPRs: Total 40 IPRs (Patents – 23 and Copyrights – 17)</li> <li>Research Publications</li> <li>AUC-IIC has been appointed as Mentor Institute with funding support by MoE.
