Along with advanced labs for Engineering, there are also new age Learning Studios for Mass Communication, Social Sciences and Fine Arts. The Library has over ten thousand volumes on diverse topics; the library is also enriched with thousands of online research journals, and a unique digital version of the library, which can be accessed by the students. The students can access various electronic information resources from online database journals, case studies, and reference and research materials. The library has two distinct sections, one that fosters collaborations and exchange of ideas among students as well as faculty, and another that facilitates concentrated and undisturbed study. Our faculty members have published more than 800 research articles in the form of research papers, books, book chapters, and conference proceedings out of which more than 425 are SCI/ABDC/Scopus/SCI indexed. In the last quarter itself, more than 100 SCI/ABDC/Scopus indexed research papers have been published and more than 75 Scopus indexed papers and book chapters have been communicated. More than 25 MoUs have been signed with industry, R&D, Health Centres, and academic institutions of National and International repute.

Faculty members have applied for more than 75 project proposals, and we have 14 sanctioned projects out of which 08 are ongoing. More than Rs. 3.0 Crores of Research funding have been received from SERB-DST, UGC, National Board of Higher Mathematics (NBHM), GAIL, Indian Council of Historical Research, National Cooperative Development Corporation, CSIR, etc. Till date more than 50 IPR have been filed in the form of patents, design, and copyrights, among which 34 have been published/awarded.

Our shining stars, our precious students have published more than 220 research articles most of which are Scopus & SCI indexed. More than 12 books have been published by the students of Amity University Jharkhand.
