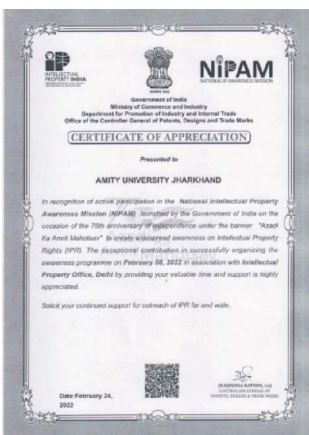

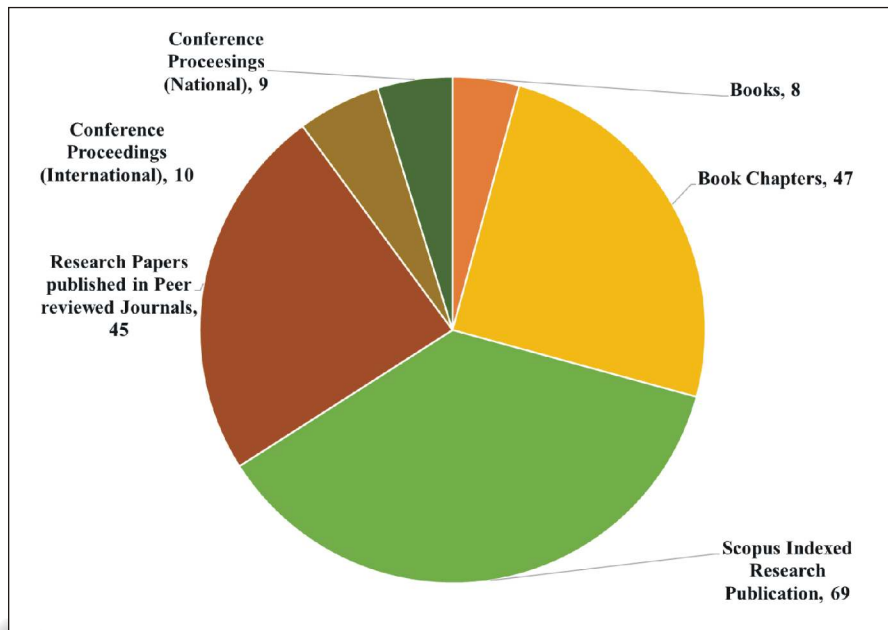
THE RESEARCH DIASPORA

Amity University Jharkhand takes immense pride in stating that it has taken long strides in the area of research and innovation in the last 6 years. Our faculty members have published 482 research articles in the form of book, book chapters, research papers and conference proceedings out of which 265 are Scopus/SCI & WoS indexed and 13 UGC CARE listed. A total of 36 books have been published till now by our distinguished faculty members. In the last quarter itself, more than 60 SCI & Scopus indexed research papers have been published and more than 40 Scopus indexed papers and book chapters have been communicated. AUJ faculty members have applied for more than 75 project proposals and we have 9 sanctioned projects in last 6 years out of which 5 are ongoing.

Over Rs. 1 crore 85 lakhs of Research funding have been received from SERB-DST, UGC, National Board of Higher Mathematics (NBHM), GAIL, Indian Council of Historical Research, National Cooperative Development Corporation, CSIR, etc. 5 patents and 2 copyrights have been granted and more than 15 patents have been applied for.

Our shining stars, our precious students have published more than 180 research papers most of which is Scopus & SCI indexed. More than 12 books have been published by the students of AUJ. An MoU has been signed between Amity Institute of Biotechnology, Amity University Jharkhand, and ICAR- Indian Institute of Agricultural Biotechnology on 04.11.2022.

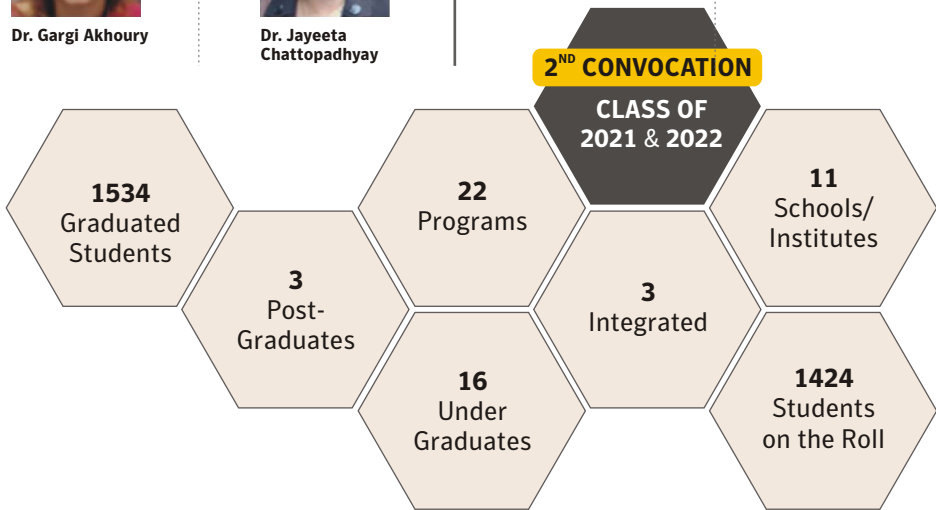

















INDUSTRY LINKAGES

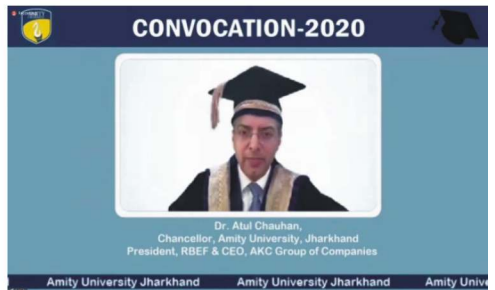
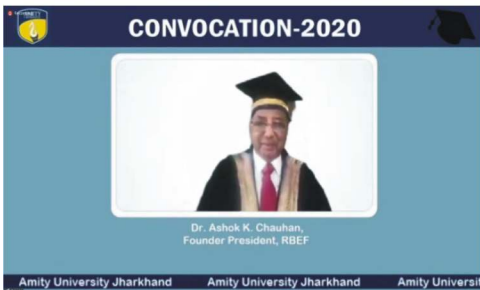


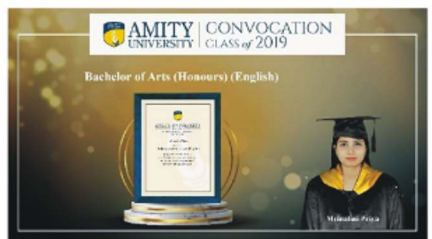
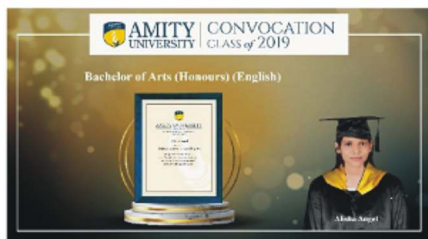
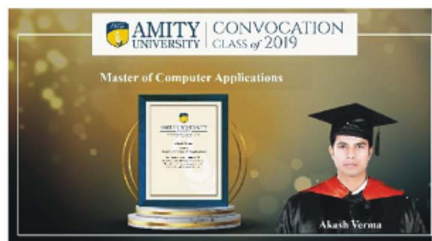
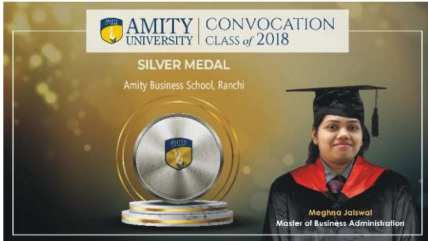
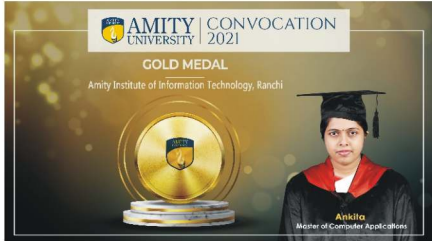
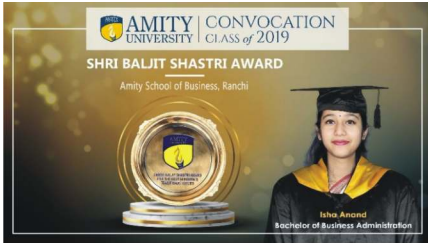
EXTENSION ACTIVITY: INTERACTION WITH HANDICAPPED CHILDREN | MAY 11, 2022
